With a degree in Philosophy of Language from the University of Turin in 1994, he completed an advanced course in General Linguistics at the Scuola Normale Superiore in Pisa. His academic career includes time as a visiting researcher at Brandeis University in Waltham, Massachusetts, and teaching roles at the University of Eastern Piedmont, the Free University of Bolzano, and the University of Turin. He has authored scientific publications both in Italy and internationally, focusing on natural language processing and artificial intelligence. A first-generation entrepreneur, he co-founded, served as president, and acted as CEO of CELI -Language Technology. In 2021, the incorporation of a CELI into H-FARM ecosystem led to the creation of MAIZE, now part of JAKALA group. In 2021, he was elected President of the ICT Companies Group of the Industrial Union of Turin, a territorial association within the Confindustria system.
